Stockists are scrambling for the little that are still

available in the hands of farmers.

We need, therefore, to stock some maize and beans now to help us with the children as from January, 2023. It's projected that as from January 2023 there will be no food since the crops have failed in the country's food baskets and prices may be unbearable.

We are working on the budget 2023 and will send it to you next Monday.


Please pray for Bumala community and Kenya as a whole. My heart goes out to those families who are in dire need right now.



#### The Nitty Gritty involved in sponsoring a child...






We thank God for the sponsors who regularly support 73 children at St Annes School – bringing a hope and a future where there would otherwise be done.

#### **BEARS TO BUMALA!**



SUCH GOOD NEWS!! 100 bears (as good as new) have been donated from folk in UK to go to the children at St Annes School. We have been trying for almost a year to ship them out but our Couriers no longer collect from locations across UK. We would have to send by Courier to Kenya Exports in Luton, UK where they could then be shipped to Mombasa and then by road to Bumala via Nairobi. GRATEFUL THANKS TO ANT and his wife ANNE who not only picked up the boxes from Derek & Annie's home and arranged to ship via DPD – but have pledged to pay for carriage! The boxed bears arrived at Kenya Exports on 5<sup>th</sup> September and are now on the high seas, due to arrive in Mombasa around 7<sup>th</sup> November. They should arrive at St Annes in good time for Christmas this year!

Thanks also to dog, Duke, for making sure operations were carried out to Health and Safety standards!!)

Many (if not all) of our children would never have received such a gift in their lives before and it gives us much joy to be able to put a smile on their faces through these acts of kindness by our wonderful supporters in UK. Look out for some lovely pics of the bears with their new owners!
